Over 250 kids turned out for T.A.P.'s annual Free Kids Fishing Derby held on May 20, 2000. Over 700 Brown, Brook, Rainbow and Palomino trout were stocked for the kids to catch. Eight trout over 18" were stocked for an added bonus. Many prizes were handed out to the kids for all the fish that were caught. The event was a great success. The Traditional Anglers of Pennsylvania would like to thank everyone who donated prizes and money to this event.

The Portage Summerfest was the scene for T.A.P.'s Casting and Fishing Demonstration held at Portage Park for kids age 16 and younger. Two rod and reel combos were given away as well as lots of other prizes. These young casting experts hit the bull's eye quite often. Thanks to the volunteers for a job well done. T.A.P. is an active member of the Portage Coalition of Sportsmen. Over 100 kids participated at the Youth Field Day held by the Coalition. They learned how to shoot shotguns, .22 rifles, and bows. The kids got first-hand experience on how to safely hunt turkeys and learned the ins-and-outs of trapping wild animals. After all that, the kids turned anglers as they tried to catch some of the trout the Coalition stocked for them.

A "Growing Greener Grant" has been awarded to the Traditional Anglers of Pennsylvania for the implementation of a watershed group to clean up Trout Run from Martindale to the mouth at the junction of the Little Conemaugh River. The amount of the grant was over \$35,000. This will be used to create a watershed group, assess the 6.3 mile Trout Run watershed and produce a watershed restoration plan.
